**NASHVILLE RECORDING ARTISTS LYNNMARIE AND CHARLIE KELLEY  
RELEASE NEW RECORDING AS THE BOXHOUNDS.**

***Instrumental Record is follow up to GRAMMY NOMINATED 'Party Dress'.***

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (August 13, 2008) -- Nashville recording artists LynnMarie and Charlie Kelley, have released a brand new CD entitled "Speechless". The follow up to the highly acclaimed and GRAMMY NOMINATED "Party Dress", this recording is LynnMarie's 10<sup>th</sup> CD within ten years. She has received four Grammy nominations for 'Best Polka Album', three of which were produced by Kelley. 'Speechless' marks their first CD as a duo named the Boxhounds.

The recording consists of 13 tracks, 11 of which are original tunes. The final two tracks are medleys of Slovenia folk songs and traditional Christmas songs. "We wanted to do a recording where the music alone could take you on a journey, and we believe this recording will do that", said LynnMarie. "From traditional, to Tex-Mex, to Cajun to completely out of the box polkas, we've tried to tap into all different styles that have affected us through the year's", said Kelley who also produced and arranged the recording.

Special guests include Ryan Joseph Ogradny (formally of the Pittsburgh based and Grammy-Nominated traditional polish band Henny & The Versa J's) and Kathy Zamejc Vogt of St. Catherines, Ontario. Ryan adds his amazing fiddle talent on two original tracks; a Cajun style polka entitled "Pinch The Tails" and a masterfully crafted melody "Sound of My Heart". Kathy, an accomplished button-accordion player, lends her expertise to the tune "Comfortable Shoes". "Kathy and I have been friends for a long time, and getting back together to record again (she was a guest on several of my earlier recordings) felt like putting on a really comfortable old pair of shoes" said LynnMarie.

The recording is also enhanced by the presence of currant band members Tony Nagy on bass guitar and Mike Zimmerman on drums. As a special added touch, Tom Baldrice, the V.P. of Marketing for Sony/BMG Records adds his amazing tuba talent to the original track "Mooi Feessie", which means 'nice party' in Dutch. The Boxhounds will play at some of the country's largest Oktoberfests this fall and will end the year with a European tour in November.
